DIRECTIONS FROM THE WEST:

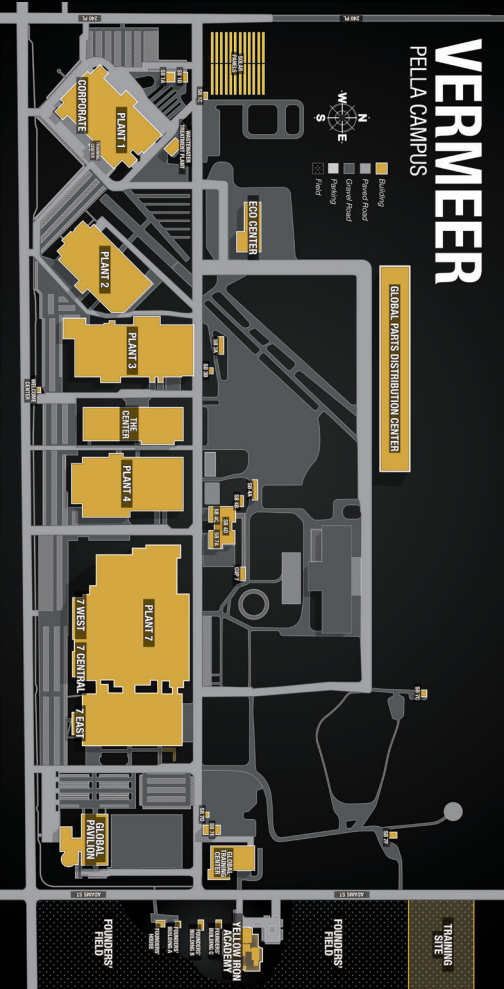
1. Take I-80 East to I-235 East (10 miles), 2. Take E. University Ave/Hwy 163 East (44 miles), 3. Take Exit 44, turn left onto Hwy 102 East/65T (1 mile), 4. Turn left onto Vermeer Road

DIRECTIONS FROM THE SOUTH:

1. Take I-35 North to Hwy 5 East (3 miles), 2. Continue on Hwy 65 north/east (1.5 miles), 3. Take Hwy 163 East (39 miles), 4. Take Exit 44, turn left onto Hwy 102 East/65T (1 mile), 5. Turn left onto Vermeer Road

DIRECTIONS FROM THE EAST:

1. Take I-80 West to Exit 173, turn left onto Hwy 224/T-22 (7 miles), 2. Turn right at stop sign onto Hwy F-62 (3 miles), 3. Turn left at stop sign onto Hwy T-14, which turns into Main Street (1.3 miles), 4. Turn left onto Washington Street, which turns into Vermeer Road (1 mile)

MEET REV. DR. MATTHEW KAEMINGK



Matthew Kaemingk is the Richard John Mouw Assistant Professor of Faith and Public Life at Fuller Theological Seminary where he also serves as the Director of the Richard John Mouw Institute of Faith and Public Life. His research and teaching focus on marketplace theology, Islam and political ethics, and public theology.

Kaemingk has written several books including "Christian Hospitality and Muslim Immigration in an Age of Fear," which was named among the best books of the year in 2018 by Christianity Today. In 2019 Kaemingk was named the "Emerging Public Intellectual of the Year" by the Redeemer Centre for Christian Scholarship. Dr. Kaemingk serves as a fellow at the Center for Public Justice and a scholar in residence at the Max De Pree Center for Christian Leadership.

Before taking the Mouw Chair, Matthew Kaemingk served as Assistant Professor of Christian Ethics and the Associate Dean of Fuller Texas. Kaemingk earned his Master of Divinity from Princeton Theological Seminary and holds doctoral degrees in Systematic Theology from the Vrije Universiteit in Amsterdam and in Christian Ethics from Fuller Theological Seminary. In 2011 he was awarded a Fulbright Scholarship to study political theology and the European conflict over Muslim immigration in Amsterdam. An ordained minister in the Christian Reformed Church, Kaemingk lives in Houston with his wife, Heather, and their three sons, Calvin, Kees, and Caedmon.
